1	Does the system have to integrate with any HR system?	Technical	No
2	How many users will need access to the LMS system	Technical	850 users
3	What is your current Learning Management System	Technical	Net Dimensions (i-Lense suite)
4	What other systems are used for Performance Management, Career and Succession Management, Recruitment and Onboarding?	Technical	SAP
5	What system do you use for Career and Development planning?	Technical	SAP
6	What is meant by black boarding?	Technical	Black boarding is a way in which the learner can use various formats to answer a question, e.g. by typing free text, via free hand drawing, by adding clipart, etc – it is a tool that provides a flexible way to answer a question. Please note that this is just an example.
7	Is the system for internal students within the IDC or is it open to an unlimited number of external students?	Technical	It is only for internal students.
8	Is it the expectation of the IDC that implementation (period of 3 months), support and licensing fees (period of 3 years) of the LMS will cost under R1 million? Is it correct that the RFP states that it is an 80/20 tender?	Admin	Effective from 1 April 2017 the new PPPFA must be used and the threshold for the preference point system has increase as follows: 80/20 increased to R50m and 90/10 applies to the value above R50m.
9	Must the LMS have document management feature (Do you need to query sharepoint content from the LMS)?	Technical	A separate document management feature is not a requirement, LMS must integrate with content management in SharePoint 2013.
10	Will the LMS be sharing authentication system with sharepoint?	Technical	IDC's SharePoint is integrated with Active Directory, and this would also be preferable for the LMS solution.
11	Do you need to access your LMS from sharepoint? If so, please elaborate?	Technical	Access via SharePoint can be via a link – the LMS system does not have to run within the SharePoint environment.

12	Is the requirement only for users to access the LMS on an ongoing basis or would you like the learners to pay each time they access a course (self-registration)?	Technical	Access on an on-going basis .
13	Would information need to be fed into the LMS from SharePoint as well as then back into Microsoft SharePoint 2013?	Technical	LMS must integrate with content management in SharePoint 2013.
