1	<p>We have a few questions in regards to a Joint venture between a well-established company trying to develop a small entity</p> <p>Is it compulsory for the small entity to have all the required certificates similar to the large entity for them to meet the gate keeping requirements</p>	Technical	<p><b>Section 12-Response format(Returnable schedule)</b> under 12.3.12, the bid document says;</p> <p>B-BBEE verification certificate indicating the contribution level of the bidding entity. An Exempted Micro Enterprises (EME) with an annual turnover less than R10 million, is only required to obtain a sworn affidavit confirming the annual total revenue and level of black ownership. A Qualifying Small Enterprise (QSE) that has 51% or more black beneficiaries may obtain a sworn affidavit confirming the annual total revenue and level of black ownership. If a bidder is a Joint Venture or Consortium, the bidder must submit a consolidated B-BBEE scorecard as if they were a group structure. Any misrepresentation in terms of the declaration constitutes a criminal offence as set out in the B-BBEE Act as amended.</p> <p><b>Note: If a bidder is a Consortium, Joint Venture or Prime Contractor with Subcontractor(s), the documents listed above (12.3.1-12.3.8) must be submitted for each Consortium/JV member or Prime Contractor and Subcontractor(s).</b></p>
