1	Prefeasibility study review: Do the bidders require to redo the survey provided that a comprehensive survey was initially completed as can be observed within the provided 2016 Prefeasibility studies report	Technical	The bidders are allowed to use their own professional discretion, however as this would require the successful bidder to take full accountability for these studies, bidders need to ascertain what information is available, and price for what further information they would need in order to complete the scope of works. This is entirely up to the bidder's discretion and professional liability. Bidders should also consider that all previous works were for Marine Infrastructure only , no previous work has been done for the landside infrastructure.
2	Prefeasibility study review: Do the bidders require to redo the full bridge simulation provided, there has been no changes to the vessels as can be observed when comparing the provided 2016 Prefeasibility studies report and current port facilities provided within the bid document	Technical	The bidders are allowed to use their own professional discretion, however as this would require the successful bidder to take full accountability of these studies, bidders need to ascertain what information is available, and price for what further information they would need in order to complete the scope of works. This is entirely up to the bidder's discretion and professional liability.
3	Clarification sought on task 2; section 3.1.1.2, bullet 2 and 10: Production of construction work packages; What execution model is required on the works to be packaged	Technical	For consistency, bidders should price for Design and Build execution model, which includes Feasibility (detailed design) and construction.
