No.	Question	Type	Answer
1	In the event that the bidding structure is a Prime Contractor with Sub-contractor/(s), how will the IDC evaluate the information provided in Annexure 2 to determine the percentage the Prime Contractor holds in terms of the value of the contract?	Technical	Please refer to paragraph 12.1 bullet 2 which speaks about Prime/Su-contractors agreement and how IDC will treat this.
2	Under 2.1 two sets of AFS are described (IDC on its own, and IDC Group). Reference is made to 30 subsidiaries and 90 associates. This RFP is only for the IDC's own AFS and the IDC Group AFS, not for producing AFS for 30 subsidiaries and 90 associates, but only to accommodate the information required for the preparation of notes within the two sets of AFS. Is this correct	Technical	Yes, this is correct
3	To confirm from Section 3 (Scope of Work) that there are only two data sources to cater for – one from SAP ERP and the second from Microsoft Database. Is this assumption correct?	Technical	Its SAP ERP, Microsoft SQL and Microsoft Excel
4	Under 3.1, the second bullet, request "Import data from MS SQL staging Database linked to the SAP ERP System". For clarification, does this require the data from the SQL database to first be linked to SAP ERP, or is the intention to link it directly to SAP DM?	Technical	No
5	Under 5.1.1 Technical Criteria, it is required to be a RESELLER (VAR) and not just a Services Partner. Does this mean that Service Partners cannot directly PRIME this implementation and has to apply via a JV/Consortium/Sub-contract to respond to this RFP?	Technical	Please refer to Mandatory Technical Requirements 5.1.1. (The bidder must be an accredited SAP Disclosure Management (SAP DM) reseller)
